Radio Install in Electric Vehicle (Continued from previous issue)

I had mentioned the accessory power outlet in this model (2022 Tesla Model S) is not 12 volts as normal. Because the accessory battery is lithium it produces 15.4 volts. As it turns out, this radio is a TYT-MD-9600 and is rated at 13.6 volts +15%. So this voltage is no problem.

The radio was mounted in the center console and is completely hidden when lid is closed. When in use the microphone fits nicely in the cupholder. When not in use it can be stowed in the radio compartment. Luckily, the power outlet is located inside the console, so power wiring was simple. A hole drilled in the side of the console accommodated the antenna coax which passed under the rear floor mat so is out of sight. A simple plywood bracket secures the radio.





Teslas all have an all glass roof, so a magnet mount antenna is out of the question. A lip mount didn't seem suitable. The antenna I chose is a two band through glass mount. The two parts attach using adhesive pads. There is a counterpoise attached on the inside. There is a trim capacitor screw on the inside unit. Using my Comet antenna analyzer, I found the UHF band below 1.5:1 SWR. The VHF band, however, was over 5:1. Trimming the capacitor all the way to maximum setting brought the SWR below 1.5:1. The UHF band seemed unaffected by the change.





Seems to work fine and what I used to check in last months net.
